1. Publicity Material -

Urges the Members who have not sent their share of the cost of production of the joint folder and poster to do so without any further delay.

2. Consumer Publications -

Appreciates the publication of two issues of "Focus on South Asia" by SITA World Travel (India) Pvt. Ltd. during 1983, and requests them to continue publication of two issues in 1984;

Welcomes the offer of Pakistan to publish two issues of "Focus on South Asia" during 1984;
