Requests the Secretariat to re-open with the European Union the Commission's proposal for technical and financial assistance to the Members for joint marketing campaigns in the major generating markets, particularly joint participation in major trade fairs and exhibitions, and accepts the offer of Sri Lanka to prepare a background paper on the subject and forward it to the Secretariat for taking further necessary action with the European Union.
