- •To help the promotion on the international level by means of obtaining the quality label of the bay's certification, on the environmental domain;



The Bay's Admission

- The applicant must fill a form and present it to the General Assembly;
- •The Bay must be recognized on the national level even international for its attractive and patrimony value, on an environment and cultural point of view. The representatives must show their full admission to the concept;



Why « incorporate » The Most Beautiful Bays in the World?

- •A new alternative to the environment;
- •A new touristic dimension on the global level;
- •A new kind of dynamic: to protect and to increase the value of the bay: a concept understood by everyone;
- A Great international human network: « effective and fraternal »;



Science Scolarship

•Launch in 2017 of a competition to award a merit research scholarship on the *preservation of the environment* and the oceans;
