Information Note

The World Tourism Organization (UNWTO) and the Principality of Andorra are organizing the 10th edition of the World Congress on Snow and Mountain Tourism with growing success

The World Congress on Snow and Mountain Tourism 2018 will discuss during these days about the impact of new platforms, artificial intelligence, training and education as key elements to achieve success in a mountain tourism destination, as well as other important issues of great importance such as the repositioning of touristic accommodation, new platform tourism services etc.

Escaldes-Engordany is located in the very center of the country, just at the confluence of the two river arms of the Valira. It is situated at 1.050m above sea-level.

Escaldes-Engordany is the only place of the Principality of Andorra with thermal springs. Escaldes-Engordany has spa hotels and also hosts the Thermal Spa Centre Caldea-Inúu.

One of the great natural treasures of Escaldes-Engordany is the Madriu-Perafita-Claror Valley with an extension of 4.247 ha where water is also a key element. The valley is of great interest not only for its natural wealth (vegetation and wildlife) but also for its cultural heritage, as a reflection of mountain life dating back to the medieval times (cabins, shepherds huts, dry stone buildings, etc.) For this reason it was declared World Cultural Heritage Site by UNESCO.

Escaldes-Engordany stands out for its extensive shopping area, its broad gastronomic diversity and a wide range of cultural offer.

The **closing session** will be held on **22 March 2018** April in the same hall of the Convention Centre at 17:45 approximately and will be followed by a farewell reception/cocktail which will terminate around 20:30.

On Friday, **23 March 2018** Andorra invites the participants to **Enjoy Andorra!**, with activities in the Thermal Spa Centre Caldea-Inúu, visits to the Museum Carmen Thyssen, the Perfume Museum, Naturlandia or Palau de Gel ice skating ring, skiing at Vallnord and GrandValira ski resorts or a ride on the tourist bus among others.

Technical visit:

On 23 March 2018 a technical visit is scheduled in Escaldes-Engordany to the Espacio de Innovación de Andorra which has been recently inaugurated by the Fundación ActuaTech. In the space for innovation diverse projects are being displayed, among them a joint initiative with researchers from the MIT Changing Places of the renowned Massachusetts Institute of Technology (MIT). The CityScope platform for Andorra allows studying different tourism models, mobility, urban planning and the environment among other demonstration of innovation in technology.

The City Scope Project integrates data derived and collected from mobility, the energy sector, parking spaces and the telecommunication providers in order to rearrange and optimize urban planning, the development of simulation systems and models capable to predict and measure the potential impact of significant interventions in the city among other features. Through these Big Data projects it is possible that Governments, public administrations and private sector companies to develop applications, services and benefits of added value and even to find solutions to important issues such as the congestion in some areas of the city and implement smart city concepts.

The number of places is limited and will be allocated by order of registration.

3. Formalidades de entrada y visados

Since participants must enter Andorra through France or Spain, citizens of states which require a visa to enter the European Union, must obtain a multi-entry/multi-exit Schengen visa in order to be able to travel to and depart from Andorra.

Interested parties may obtain the visa in the appropriate diplomatic or consular missions.

Delegates are requested to obtain their visa prior to travelling, in order to avoid any difficulties that might arise in the border posts of both Spain and France.

In the absence of Spanish or French diplomatic representation in their countries, delegates are requested to go to any diplomatic or consular mission of other signatories of the Schengen Agreement in their home countries in order to obtain a Schengen visa.

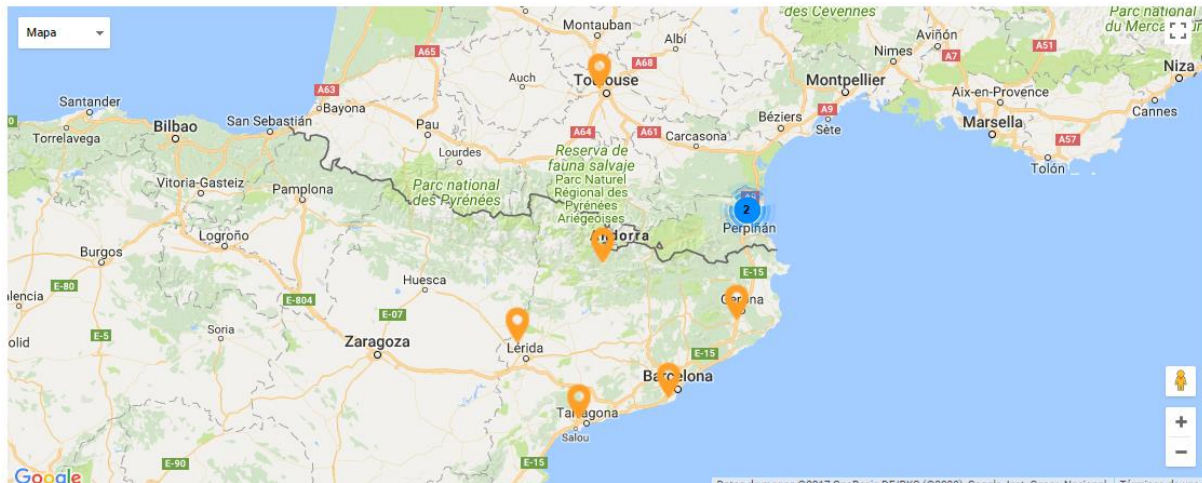

4. Transporte y acceso a Andorra

- **By air:**

Andorra has no airports within its territory but within a radius of 200km there are several international airports; Toulouse-Blagnac (TLS), Carcassonne (CCF), Girona-Costa Brava (GRO), Barcelona-El Prat (BCN) and Reus (REU).

Participants who come by plane should fly to Barcelona (Spain) or to Toulouse (France). Many international routes connect the two cities with different destinations worldwide. From both airports Andorra is accessible by road, either by private vehicle or regular bus line.

In 2015 the Andorra – la Seu d’Urgell Airport has been inaugurated. It is located some 20km from Andorra (aprox. 20 minutes by car) www.aeroportandorralaseu.cat. - **By road:**

From Barcelona, the route to Andorra goes through the Vallvidrera tunnels heading to Manresa, Túnel del Cadí, La Seu d’Urgell and Andorra. Journey time is approx. 2 hours.

It is possible to take an alternative route without tolls through the Martorell A2 motorway heading towards Cervera-Lleida, and passing through Guissona, Pons and Seu d’Urgell. Journey time is 2 hours 30 minutes.

From Toulouse, the route to Andorra is the A61 motorway heading towards Montpellier - Foix, and taking the exit to the Nacional 20 highway, heading towards Andorra – Pas de la Casa. Journey time is 2 hours 30 minutes.

- **By bus:**

Two bus companies service the route from El Prat airport in Barcelona (Spain) and from Toulouse - Blagnac (France) to Andorra.

• **Airports – shuttle service**

11. Practical information

- **Climate**

Andorra enjoys a high mountain climate with Mediterranean influences. In winter temperatures are rather cold and mild during the summer season with wide variations depending on altitude and orientation.

Andorra has a very high percentage of sunny days and the climate is dry. The average annual minimum is 4°C and the average maximum is 16°C. During the month of March, the temperature variation during the day is pronounced, with minimum temperatures of 0°C in the mornings and evenings, and maximums of 12°C in the middle of the day.

- **Local time**

Andorra is one hour ahead of the Greenwich Mean Time (GMT + 1).

- **Currency**

The common currency in Andorra is the Euro. All banks provide currency exchange services and ATMs are available 24 hours a day. International credit cards such as Visa, MasterCard and American Express, among others, are accepted.

- **Language**

The official language is Catalan. Spanish and French are also commonly used languages in the Principality.

- **Banks and currency exchange**

Bank branches open Monday to Friday from 9:00 to 13:00 and 15:00 to 17:00. Some branches open without interruption from 9:00 to 17:00. Banks are closed Saturdays and Sundays.

- **Business hours**

More than 2000 shops of the Principality open every day (including Sundays). Opening hours are generally from 10 a.m. to 8 p.m., and until 9 p.m. on Saturdays.

- **Electricity**

Electrical current is 220 volt/50 Hz. Outlets take plugs with two round pins.

- **Telephone**

The international code of Andorra is 376. Most foreign mobile phones work in Andorra. It is possible to purchase prepaid SIM cards through the following provider:

- **Andorra WiFi**

Andorra WiFi is the public WiFi network of Andorra Telecom provided in the two main shopping streets of Andorra la Vella and Escaldes-Engordany.

This network allows two types of connection:

Free basic connection: This connection provides access to the websites of Andorra, national applications and websites of participating shops. It also allows access to Google Business Photos and Google Street View.

Internet connection: With this connection it is possible to use and view any application and website on the Internet, including instant messaging apps (WhatsApp, Line and WeChat) as well as voice-over-IP (Skype and Facetime).
