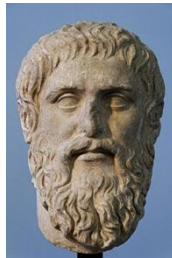


The Sagan Series is an educational project working in the hopes of promoting scientific literacy in the general population.

# International development

- ✓ Lacks a clear definition – sometimes called ‘global development’
- ✓ Often linked with human development, economic development & international efforts to reduce poverty
- ✓ Can be traced back to the work of Plato - ‘The Republic’ - what is meant by a “just” society

*Plato (around 420 BC to around 347 BC) - founder of the Academy in Athens, the first institution of higher learning in the Western world - laid the very foundations of Western philosophy & science*
