In this session, the panellists will analyse the technical and human resources requirements needed for the development and implementation of a Tourism Satellite Account based on the International recommendations for tourism statistics and TSA recommended Methodological framework. ### **Session two: Establishing a statistical tourism framework for Measuring Sustainable Tourism in Africa**
